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What are your coach training philosophies?

The philosophy that shapes the Adventures in Wisdom Life Coaching Program for Kids™ is one of empowerment through mindset. Our goal is to bring awareness to kids about just how powerful their thoughts are in shaping who they are and how they experience their lives. We want to help all kids to see their greatness and learn how to create an extraordinary life!

What delivery method does your program use? (e.g.Face to Face, Virtual)

We serve an international market so all of our training is provided virtually and/or on-demand.

New coaches can complete their new coach certification training on-demand. The training is available in both audio and PDF formats.

Our ongoing coach training is delivered via teleconference and all sessions are recorded so that coaches may listen to the training on their own time.

How many participants typically attend your program?

Participants are certified individually and can be certified at any time.

What are the foundational core competencies that your program supports?

The 11-ICF Core Competencies. Our coaches:

- Learn to create a safe and trusting environment for their child clients
- Use of presence, active listening skills, and questioning skills to help kids open up and share
- Create awareness through the use of stories and activates and which helps kids see new possibilities and take empowered action in their lives
- teach kids how to create a vision for their lives and how to set and achieve their goals.

Who are your students?

The vast majority of our students are life coaches who are passionate about making a positive difference in children's lives.



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What philosophy(s) does your program use for the personal development of coaches?

We believe that to be a powerful coach and a powerful person we should always “be in the work” ourselves. Our program is all about personal development and our coaches continually comment that they are learning just as much as the kids are.

What do you do to support your students to determine the ROI of a coaching relationship?

Our coaches are encouraged to talk with their child clients and that child’s parents to discuss what they are getting from the coaching relationship. For our coaches, “ROI” is more of a qualitative measure versus a quantitative measure.

What kind of support, if any, does your program offer to your learners in developing a coaching business or managing an internal coaching program?

We provide ongoing marketing support and training. Coaches are given access to marketing tools to help them with their business. Example of tools include a set of articles that they can use in their nurture program (eZine, blog, etc.), a set of coaching package templates that they can use to design coaching packages or workshops, and access to a private Facebook Group. Once certified, WISDOM Coaches are listed on our website. We also provide ongoing training in the areas of marketing, personal development, and business development.

What, if any, are the prerequisites for a student to enter your program?

The most important prerequisite to enter our program is to have a passion for inspiring and empowering kids. Our enrollment process does an excellent job of attracting the most appropriate students to our program.
