At-Large Board Members

Two-year terms for up to 3 terms

1. The Nominating Committee will begin the process of accepting nominations for the At-Large Board members annually in late March.


2. All Individual members and member organizations will receive an electronic ballot annually in April to vote for a proposed slate of new officers and board members. The new board will be introduced at the ACTO Conference in June.
