ACTO MEMBER HIGHLIGHT

Serendipity brought me all the meaningful people, things and occurrences that have shaped and filled my life. Each time, it was an answer to a longing or a prayer that I wasn't even aware I had, till later. All I did was say an intuitive, openhearted 'yes' to whatever showed up, and then worked hard to manifest the potential.

Coaching too 'found' me, around one corner of life's lanes. I have not looked back. Today,

after a dozen years, I am many things coaching and leadership, but most of all, I am a person applying the core of coaching to her conversation with life itself. I believe that an authentic conversation is the most fundamental tool to enable transformation. For me, it is a spiritual path – for finding alignment, assuming ownership, and making choices that honour the wholeness of our existence. My internal conversation continues to evolve into greater emotional freedom. And, with that, my expression in the world also expands.

Playing several different roles of a coach, a trainer, a mentor, a coach supervisor and a non-profit leader, has given me the opportunity to work with a diverse spectrum of individuals and groups from greatly privileged to greatly marginalized, global to local. I could not be more grateful. You can imagine my joy that not only have I such a practice/path, but I can enable the same for others.

Coaching came to me a couple of years after I had started a non-profit, after school learning center for children (www.auraplace.org). I had few skills in my quiver injust the love of a young mother's heart about what children need to thrive, and a desire to offer them a space where they could 'transform fear into love'. When I found 'the coaching approach', I immediately trained all my team members with coaching skills and presence work.

Over time, that small garden with intuitively designed activities for small groups of children, has now expanded to build self-awareness and leadership capacity for children and youth from marginalized communities in and around my hometown in India. We have outreach and training programs for nearly 1500 participants each year, with an average input of 40 hours of training for everyone. We have now expanded our focus to influence systemic change by working with educators in schools and universities.

I presented at the online ACTO conference in 2021, and then served as Co-Chair for the conference the following year, and I recently joined the ACTO Board as Chair of the Education Committee. Coaching has given me so much, and ACTO is a step in my desire to give back to the field. We need a body that stands for authentic inclusion, not tokenism. I believe ACTO can move in that direction and become more!
