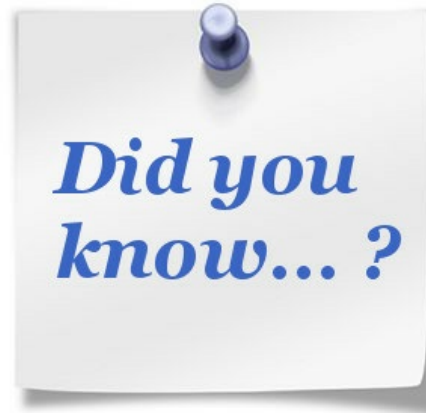

Reimagining ACTO Committees in Support of Members and Coach Education

For the past few months, our Board Development Committee has devoted their time and energy in a full review the current ACTO committee structure and created a new structure to re-align the committees based on five core areas of focus. We invite you to review each committee and [reach out to us](#) for details on how YOU can join an ACTO Committee in service of excellence in coach education at your school and beyond.

1- Board Development Committee

The purpose of the Board Development Committee (BDC) is to formalize and develop procedures to support the robust functioning of the board by overseeing a nomination process that ensures the diversity, expertise, and commitment of board members; and the ongoing learning and development of the board as to meet the demand of strategic initiatives of the organization.

2- Education/Research Committee

The purpose of the Education/Research Committee (ERC) is to provide members with high quality education to achieve the level of knowledge and skill necessary to serve constituents with competence and professionalism; and to encourage and support research that expands and evolves current thinking and practice.

3- Communications/Community Relations Committee Charter

The Communications and Community Relations Committee (CCRC) is responsible to establish and maintain strategic alignment and the standards of our public persona in meetings, events, on the website, and all internet venues. It will maintain liaison with the Board and other committees to ensure strategic alignment of messaging, and narratives that reflect and shape the industry

4- Marketing/Membership Committee

The purpose of the Membership Committee (MMC) is to differentiate offers and services within the industry and community to advance membership growth, retention and benefits by promoting the ACTO brand. The MMC will also act as a resource to members to help navigate the organization's services and benefits.

5- Ethics and Professional Responsibility Committee Charter

The Ethics and Professional Responsibility (EPRC) is responsible for initiating and facilitating the development and review of standards, guidelines, best practices and ethics that promote competence and professionalism in coaching.
